CCRI offers Bayside Summer Adventure. Combine the park settings, the dedicated staff, the exciting array of activities and you have the ingredients for a true summer adventure. Your child will participate in a variety of outdoor, recreational & educational experiences designed for all ages & abilities. Bayside offers several different fun filled day camp options for youth ages 4–15. The Little Camp - Ages 4 to 6

♦Cost: \$125 per week, per child ♦Offered sessions 2,4,6,8

This partial day program is offered from 10:00am until 2:00pm daily. Children participate in a variety of acitivites with emphasis on fun and exploration. Games, sports, ooey gooey science, messy mixtures, arts & crafts, nature activities will make the time fly by. Limited enrollment. Transportation is not provided for this camp.



Camp White Tail – Ages 5 to 8

(Completion of Kindergarten recommended – not required)

♦Cost: \$180 per week, per child ♦Offered sessions 1,2,4,6,7,8,9,10

Children participate in a variety of acitivites that they have chosen with emphasis on fun and exploration. Sports (soccer, t-ball & others), ooey gooey science, messy mixtures, edible art, learn about birds, dinosaurs & fossils, pirates & treasure, arts & crafts, and nature activities to name a few. Optional Family Camp-Out Session 6 - July 26th.



Camp Ultimate – Ages 8 to 13

♦Cost: \$180 per week, per child **♦Offered sessions 1,2,4,6,7,8,9,10**

Set up to provide children a wide variety of acitivites from sports (soccer, lacrosse, golf, football, rollerblading, basketball, baseball), arts and crafts (drawing, cartooning, painting), science, crabbing, fishing, canoeing, hiking, exploring, nature activities, group games, water games, drama, dance, puppetry and so much more. Optional Camp-Outs are offered Session 2 (June 28th), Session 4 (July 12th), Session 6 (July 26th-families only), Sessions 7 & 9 (August 2nd & 16th).

...Adventures, Travel, Exploring ** New Activities for 2012!

Affordable overnight camp experiences! Two sessions are offered. Very limited enrollment for older campers 9–15 (both camps filled last year!). We will use Broadneck Park for Monday drop off and Friday pick up. Transportation from Crofton and Annapolis will also be available. These camps are for older participants and all participants should be able to swim.

The emphasis is on having fun and getting "wet"! We will head to Williamsburg and Busch Gardens, spending a day at Busch Gardens and another at Water Country USA! Exploring the state park and a visit to Virginia Beach should also help beat the summer heat and make this a fun filled week. Tent camping at a Virginia State park will provide our base camp for the week. Participants should be able to swim.





...Discovery, Exciting, Fun

♦ Age: 8-13 ♦ Cost: Included in regular Day Camp fee

This extension of our Day Camp program is designed to meet the needs of children who have special interests or are interested in developing new ones. Specialty Camp programs combine an eight hour per week specialty focus with the remainder of time spent at Camp Ultimate.

Nature/Science Camp - Session 2 June 25th-29th

For the child that loves nature and science. Children will take a close-up look at things that "fly" as well as other animals and their habitats. Campers will also see what happens as we use ordinary things in extraordinary ways!

Soccer/Sports Camp - Session 4 July 9th-13th

For the child that loves sports. Camp will have an emphasis on soccer fundamentals, but this not too competitive camp will also include other sports that will focus on skill development and team work.

Creative Arts - Session 6 July 23rd -27th

Drawing, painting, tie dying, plaster of paris, weaving, stained glass, & candle making are just some of the possible art mediums to be explored in this popular "hands-on" art experience.

Cooking for Kids - Session 8 Aug. 6th -10th


