CCRI offers Bayside Summer Adventure. Combine the park settings, the dedicated staff, the exciting array of activities and you have the ingredients for a true summer adventure. Your child will participate in a variety of outdoor, recreational & educational experiences designed for all ages & abilities. From crabbing, fishing, canoeing, sports, art, nature & science, there is so much to do!

Bayside offers several different fun filled day camp options for youth ages 4–15. Little Camp, a half day program for ages 4-6, Camp White Tail (full day) for ages 5-8 and Camp Ultimate (full day) for ages 8-13 are offered at Sandy Point State Park. We also offer two one week Overnight Camps for ages 9–15. Older teens (14–15) can also be a part of camp by participating in a Leadership Trainee Program.

Unlike most day camps, Camp White Tail and Camp Ultimate place campers based on their interests. Campers are grouped more by activity choice rather than by age. Each week you and your child can create a camp based on how they want to spend their time at camp by selecting from a wide variety of activities that change weekly.

The Little Camp - Ages 4 to 6

◇ **Cost:** \$125 per week, per child ◇ **Offered sessions 2,4,6,8**

This partial day program is offered from 10:00am until 2:00pm daily. Children participate in a variety of activities with emphasis on fun and exploration. Games, sports, ooey gooey science, messy mixtures, arts & crafts, nature activities will make the time fly by. Limited enrollment. Transportation is not provided for this camp.



Camp White Tail – Ages 5 to 8

(Completion of Kindergarten recommended – not required)

◇ **Cost:** \$180 per week, per child ◇ **Offered sessions 1,2,4,6,7,8,9,10**

Children participate in a variety of activities that they have chosen with emphasis on fun and exploration. Sports (soccer, t-ball & others), ooey gooey science, messy mixtures, edible art, learn about birds, dinosaurs & fossils, pirates & treasure, arts & crafts, and nature activities to name a few. Optional Family Camp-Out Session 6 - July 26th.



Camp Ultimate – Ages 8 to 13

◇ **Cost:** \$180 per week, per child ◇ **Offered sessions 1,2,4,6,7,8,9,10**

Set up to provide children a wide variety of activities from sports (soccer, lacrosse, golf, football, rollerblading, basketball, baseball), arts and crafts (drawing, cartooning, painting), science, crabbing, fishing, canoeing, hiking, exploring, nature activities, group games, water games, drama, dance, puppetry and so much more. Optional Camp-Outs are offered Session 2 (June 28th), Session 4 (July 12th), Session 6 (July 26th-families only), Sessions 7 & 9 (August 2nd & 16th).

These camps are for older participants and all participants should be able to swim.



Coasters, Beach, Water and More!

◇Age: 9-15

◇Cost: \$410

◇ Session 3 July 2nd-6th

The emphasis is on having fun and getting "wet"! We will head to Williamsburg and Busch Gardens, spending a day at Busch Gardens and another at Water Country USA! Exploring the state park and a visit to Virginia Beach should also help beat the summer heat and make this a fun filled week. Tent camping at a Virginia State park will provide our base camp for the week. Participants should be able to swim.



Outdoor Adventure Camp

◇ Age: 9-15

◇ Cost: \$395

◇ Session 5 - July 16th-20th

On Monday we will head towards Frederick, MD and will make a stop to spend some time at a local theme park. Camping, swimming and waterfalls will provide the backdrop for the rest of this fun-filled week. Planned activities include the popular mountain coaster, swimming, group games and hiking. Additional activities may include, all-terrain boards, tubing, caving, water slides, or go carts. Participants should be able to swim.



Specialty Camps - Ages 8-13

...Discovery, Exciting, Fun

◇Age: 8-13 ◇Cost: Included in regular Day Camp fee

This extension of our Day Camp program is designed to meet the needs of children who have special interests or are interested in developing new ones. Specialty Camp programs combine an eight hour per week specialty focus with the remainder of time spent at Camp Ultimate.

Nature/Science Camp - Session 2 June 25th-29th

For the child that loves nature and science. Children will take a close-up look at things that "fly" as well as other animals and their habitats. Campers will also see what happens as we use ordinary things in extraordinary ways!

Soccer/Sports Camp - Session 4 July 9th-13th

For the child that loves sports. Camp will have an emphasis on soccer fundamentals, but this not too competitive camp will also include other sports that will focus on skill development and team work.

Creative Arts - Session 6 July 23rd-27th

Drawing, painting, tie dying, plaster of paris, weaving, stained glass, & candle making are just some of the possible art mediums to be explored in this popular "hands-on" art experience.

Cooking for Kids - Session 8 Aug. 6th-10th

Children learn to prepare, present & feast on their own creations in this unique outdoor, "hands-on" cooking program. Mixing, measuring, cooking....eating. Home-made ice cream, root-beer anyone?



Teen Leadership Trainee Program - Ages 14-15

...Learning, Teaching, Growing



Held at Sandy Point State Park, this program (Session 2–June 25th-June 29th) is designed to help today's teen develop their own sense of responsibility & leadership potential. LT's will participate in a variety of discussions & activities centered on personal growth and development. LT's will also be encouraged to participate, assist and possibly lead certain camp activities. Successful completion allows teens to sign up for additional sessions. Cost: \$100
